

OFFICIAL CALL
Mass Meeting of Roanoke City Committee
of the Republican Party of Virginia

As Chairman of the Roanoke City Committee of the Republican Party of Virginia, and pursuant to the Plan of Organization and as recommended and directed by the Committee, I, Charlie Nave, do hereby issue this call for a Mass Meeting to be held at the Holiday Inn at 3315 Ordway Dr NW, Roanoke, VA 24017, starting at 2:00 PM local time (doors will open at 1:30 PM) on March 17th, 2018, for the following purposes:

1. Electing a Chairman for the Roanoke City Republican Committee
2. Electing the members of the Roanoke City Republican Committee
3. Electing three nominees for Roanoke City Council and one nominee for Roanoke City Mayor
4. Electing up to 1184 Delegates and an equal number of Alternates to the 6th District Republican Committee Convention, to be held on May 19, 2018 at the JMU Convocation Center, 895 University Blvd, Harrisonburg, VA 22807 (or its alternate site) beginning at 10am for the purposes of
 - i. Electing a Chairman for the Sixth Congressional District of the Virginia Republican Party of Virginia;
 - ii. Electing three (3) Regional Vice Chairman for the Sixth Congressional District of the Republican Party of Virginia;
 - iii. Nominating a Republican Candidate for the office of the U.S. House of Representatives;
 - iv. The transaction of such other business that may properly come before the Sixth Congressional District Convention.
5. And for the transaction of such other business as may properly come before the mass meeting.

Qualifications for Participation

All legal and qualified voters of Roanoke City under the laws of the Commonwealth of Virginia, regardless of race, religion, national origin or sex, who are in accord with the principles of the Republican Party, and who, if requested, express in open meeting either orally or in writing as may be required their intent to support all of its nominees for public office in the ensuing election may participate as members of the Republican Party of Virginia in its mass meetings, party canvasses, conventions, or primaries encompassing their respective election districts.

In addition to the foregoing, to be in accord with the principles of the Republican Party, unless otherwise stipulated by the appropriate Official Committee, a person otherwise qualified hereunder shall not have participated in Virginia in the nomination process of a party other than the Republican Party within the last five years.

A single exception to the above shall be approved for a voter that renounces affiliation with any other party in writing, and who expresses in writing that he/she is in accord with the principles of

the Republican Party and intends, at the time of the writing, to support the nominees of the Republican Party in the future. Any voter that utilizes the foregoing exception, and thereafter participates in the nomination process of a party other than the Republican Party, shall not have the benefit of the exception identified in this paragraph thereafter. Within 30 days of receipt, the Official Committee shall provide a copy of this signed renunciation statement to the Republican Party of Virginia, to be maintained for a period of 5 years.

Filing Requirements

Delegates:

Candidates for election as Delegates (and Alternates) to the May 19th District Convention may notify the Chairman of the Committee of his or her intention by pre-filing pursuant to the requirements stated herein. Candidates who pre-file do not need to be present at the Mass Meeting to be elected as a delegate. Candidates for delegate must prefile by 5:00PM on March 9th, 2018. Postmarks do not govern. There will be no nominations from the floor for Delegates or Alternates to the May 19th District Convention.

City Council and Mayor:

Candidates for election as City Councilman or Mayor at said Mass Meeting shall file a written statement in any of the methods prescribed for Candidates for Delegate (above). Such statements must be received not later than 7:00PM on February 12th, 2018. Postmarks will not govern. There will be no nominations from the floor for City Council or Mayor.

Filing shall be in the form of a statement delivered as described above. The statement shall indicate that the candidate seeks the nomination as a Republican Candidate for City Council or Mayor, and shall state that the candidate is a resident of, and registered to vote in Roanoke City, and that he or she is in accord with the principles of the Republican Party.

Chairman:

Candidates for election to the position of Chairman of the Roanoke City Republican Committee shall file a written statement of intent either by mail or by hand delivery to Melanie Rice, Vice Chair at 2821 Wycliffe SW Roanoke VA 24014, which must be received not later than 5:00PM on February 12th, 2018. Postmarks will not govern. There will be no nominations from the floor for the office of Chairman.

Cancellation of Mass Meeting

If only one candidate files for chairman, then said candidate shall be declared chairman. If in addition to there being only one chairman candidate, there are also no candidates filed for local office by the February 12th filing deadline and if the maximum number of delegates are not filed by the March 9th filing deadline, then no mass meeting will be held.

In such an event, the members of the committee and all candidates for delegate who pre-file before the mass meeting (and meet the requirements of the call) will be deemed elected as of the March 9th filing deadline.
